What might be overlooked here?

Can you photograph an everyday object around us almost like an 'artefact'?

What feels hidden or revealed by the arches?

How do light and shadow transform these spaces?

Can you capture multiple layers of time here?

How do modern buildings sit alongside older history?

Artists are often inspired by their surroundings. What might inspire an archaeologist here?

What past appears in its architecture, sculptures, or decorative details?

Think of monument as 'markers' in the archaeological record. Can you capture how people interact with this site today?

Play with scale: Towering column v.s. Tiny carved stone v.s. Human presence.

Can you photograph traces of performances or storytelling in this space?

Look at worn steps, entrances, masks, or statues. What echoes of past audiences might still linger?

What layers of power, memory, or history can you reveal here?

Can you find traces of time in overlooked areas like steps, railings, or weathered stonework?
